
The most common surname in the Czech Republic is **Novák** (Nováková).

There are around 70 000 people waring this surname. Another widely spread surnames are Svoboda (Svobodová\*) (25 160 m. + 35 320f.), Novotný (Novotná\*) (24 233 m. + 25 231 f.), Dvořák (Dvořáková\*) (22 200 m. + 23 341 f.), Černý (Černá\*) (17 802 m. + 18 429 f.).

The most popular male names in the Czech Republic are Jiří (319 593). Jan (271 832), Petr (260 631), Josef () and Pavel (207 428).

The most popular female names are Marie (332 918), Jana (275 141), Eva (161 309), Anna (151 558) and Hana (151 179).



## INTEREST


Region Vysočina has 517 153 inhabitants. The administrative district of Telč is 291,4 square kilometers with 13,581 inhabitants (46,6 inhabitants per square kilometer). The town itself has 5809 inhabitants (in 2005). In 1991 there were 6049 inhabitants and in 1961 there were 5146 inhabitants.

The administrative district of Prešť is 170,2 square kilometers with 11,466 inhabitants (7,4 inhabitants per square kilometer). The town itself has 5809 inhabitants.

#### History of the school

Otokar Brezina gymnázium in Telc is the oldest Czech secondary school in the south-west of Moravia. It was founded in 1852. A great number of its former students became famous in various fields both home and abroad. The school is named after the Czech poet Otokar Brezina, who was studying here since 1883 till 1887.

#### Our school

To enter the Nigh school, the candidates sit written tests. Thirty of them are enrolled into both young and high forms.

#### Programme of studies

There is an eight year programme of studies (after the fifth class of basic school) or a four year programme (after the ninth class of basic school). Studies are of general character, registration number 75,25500. The school offers a good general education with partial specialization in high forms.


